This environmental policy is central to the company's operations.

O.W. Tankers A/S recognise exposure of risk to surrounding environment. The company has therefore prepared extensive instructions, complying with both national and international requirements as well as with rules formulated by Classification Society and demands of Major Charterers, to minimise latent risk.

These instructions, which concern various anti pollution precautions and training manuals, are to contribute to:

- ⇒ Prevention of pollution and other damage to the environment, in particular the marine environment.
- ⇒ Clean marine environment
- ⇒ Identifying pollution risks and hazards.
- ⇒ Maintenance of high environmental conscious safety standards onboard.
- ⇒ Preparing for emergencies related to pollution
- ⇒ Onward Company's reputation as a environmental friendly Company
- ⇒ Regular inspections of equipment and reviews of procedures to ensure compliance with modern safety management.
- ⇒ Good and easy co-operation with maritime and land based authorities.
- ⇒ Regular training "on the job" as well as land based courses of personnel to ensure that they will, at any time, be qualified to perform respective jobs.
- ⇒ Correct treatment of carried products, detailed instructions describing appropriate procedures, have been prepared and distributed to the vessels.

We practice a "non blame" culture and we aim towards the highest degree of environmentally awareness; with 0 (zero) pollutions. We urge the staff to report any environmental deficiency that would provide the company with a possibility to develop and raise the level of environmentally awareness.
